3A - Beginner Rider Division A - Open to beginner riders ages 7 - 9 yo who are confident riding independently at the walk and trot.

3B - Beginner Rider Division B - open to beginner riders ages 10-17 yo who are confident riding independently at the walk and trot.

Rules & Regulations

General

- Show is open primarily to SHS riders, but SHS reserves the right and may invite riders from other barns.
- **SHS Instructors will recommend the appropriate Division(s) & horses for their riders.**
- **Every effort is made to assign the requested horse for the rider, but horse assignment may include random draw prior to the Show.**
- Equishare riders may ride their Equishare horses.
- Seaton Hackney Stables reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes if necessary.
- **No dogs permitted on the property near the rings on the day of the Show.**

Timeliness & show attire

- As customary with showing, times are approximate.
- Each participant should arrive **at least** 45 minutes before her/his first scheduled class. Should you miss your class/division, we cannot enter you in another section or in another class/division. There will be no refunds unless the class is cancelled.
- Show attire will include: riding breeches, short or tall boots, collared white shirt and show coat (optional) OR Seaton Hackney T-Shirt and regulatory riding helmet.

Fees

- **Please Note: No refunds will be issued for missed/forfeited classes or failure to come to the Show.**
- **Entry fees are \$95 per Division. Additional Divisions at a discount. Fee includes use of SHS horse. Riders register for all classes in their division and cannot select individual classes.**
- **There are no registration fees or late fees.**
- **Barn Bucks are welcome towards 50% of entry fees.**

Judging

- We reserve the right to combine or split classes depending upon the number of participants in each class/Division. This may result in scheduling changes.
- Except for Jumpers Divisions, riders are judged on their equitation skills and the horse they ride will not affect the judge's decision.
