

Rules & Regulations

General

- Show is open primarily to SHS riders, but SHS reserves the right and may invite riders from other barns.
- SHS Instructors will recommend the appropriate Division(s) & horses for their riders.
- **Every effort is made to assign a horse for the rider, but horse assignment may include random draw prior to the Show.**
- Equishare Riders may ride their Equishare Horses
- Seaton Hackney Stables reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes if necessary.
- **No dogs permitted on the property near the rings on the day of the Show**

Timeliness & show attire

- **As customary with showing, times are approximate.**
- Each participant should arrive at least 30 minutes before her/his first scheduled class. Should you miss your class/Division, we cannot enter you in another section or in another class/Division. **There will be no refunds unless the class is cancelled.**
- Show attire will include riding breeches, short or tall boots, collared white shirt and show coat (optional) OR Seaton Hackney T-shirt and regulatory riding helmet.

Fees

Please note: No refunds will be issued for missed/forfeited classes or failure to come to Show.

- Entry fees are \$95 per Division. **Additional Divisions at a discount. Fee includes use of SHS horses. Riders register for all classes in their division and cannot select individual classes.**
- **There are no registration fees or late fees.**
- **Barn Bucks are welcome towards 1/3 of Entry fees**

Judging

- We reserve the right to combine or split classes depending upon the number of participants in each class/Division. This may result in scheduling changes.
- Except for Jumpers Divisions, riders are judged on their equitation skills and the horse they ride will not affect the judge's decision.

Compete in all three shows for a chance to receive special prizes following the Series Finale on Sunday, September 13th!

Points are awarded as follows:

- 1st place: 7 pts
- 2nd place: 5 pts
- 3rd place: 4 pts
- 4th place: 3 pts
- 5th place: 2 pts
- 6th place: 1 pt

Riders with the most cumulative points per division will receive rewards at the end of the series!

Represent that every horse, rider, driver, and handler is eligible as entered; 3. Agree to hold the competition, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; 4. Agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, they authorize the competition management to market, transfer, assign or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, film, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes or videotapes taken of the horse(s) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident, to or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site in any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the event, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service and to invasion of privacy, right of publicity or to misappropriation, and 5. Agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk or serious injury or death and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss and they agree to indemnify and hold the competition and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition whether or not such claim, injury or loss resulted directly from the negligent acts or omissions or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of competition.
